PARTICIPANTS

The meeting brought together more than 100 participants, including experts from different international, regional and national organizations and institutions. Researchers from Gynuity and experts from organizations which have substantial work in postabortion care, such as Concept Foundation, FIGO, Global Doctors for Choice, Guttmacher Institute, Ibis Reproductive Health, IPAS, IPPF, The Population Council, Venture Strategies Innovations, WHO and UNFPA. A number of country teams in two UNFPA regions (Arab States and Africa) which have programmes for increasing access to postabortion care and linking it to family planning, as well as countries which are moving towards decreasing maternal mortality through a variety of interventions participated in the meeting. Country teams included representatives from Ministries of Health, UNFPA Country Offices, professional organizations, media and prominent NGOs working in this area. National coordinators of FIGO initiative on prevention of unsafe abortion were also invited.
